**Note 1** Activities described 'per year' means each year starting on the anniversary of your renewal

**Note 2** Informal Mentoring is not part of a formal training programme but means where a coach is learning by receiving advice or help from a more senior, or more experienced coach. To qualify as CPD informal mentoring must:-  
a. Be a relationship where there is real professional development taking place  
b. Where the mentor is a coach of a more Senior Grade or of the same grade but with much more experience  
c. Involve a commitment by both parties to work together over a period of time. To qualify in each year there shall be evidence of a relationship extending over at least 4 months  
d. Significant communication between the parties in person, by phone or email  
e. The mentor must be one of the nominated referees and can expect to be contacted by the renewal panel, particularly if it is a coach of the same grade.

**Note 3** To qualify the period of working with sports specialists shall cover a number of substantial events such as a years squad programme or a similar event. As an alternative a longer standing working relationship can qualify if it meets the criteria detailed in note 2.

**Note 4** To qualify the work with a more senior coach shall comprise working at a 'structured' event such as performance workshop or squad or programmed performance coaching

**Note 5** Limited CPD, that is not specific to Archery Coaching, may be claimed. For example items 021 & 022 could have been obtained at work. In these cases the applicant should explain their relevance as Archery Coaching CPD.

**Note 6** A Published Paper should be a substantial and original work, made generally available, of at least 2000 words, possibly supported by a PowerPoint presentation, which outlines a basic concept or problem, discusses it and leads the reader to a specific conclusion from which they can learn.

**Note 7** Only work on a regular basis with NSG or a National Coaching Framework group will be acceptable to qualify unless specifically agreed with NCOEd

**Note 8** Workshop sessions contained within the programmes of Conferences or Seminars do NOT attract CPD points in addition to the points allowed for the whole event.
